SUEZ Makes Its First Delivery to Mexico's major LNG Import Facility in Altamira

SUEZ Energy International today announced that it has delivered its first LNG cargo to the newly operational Altamira re-gasification terminal on Mexico's northeast coast on February 17, 2007. Through this shipment, the company has now served all seven existing LNG import facilities in North America.

The 138,000 cubic meter cargo was delivered on the LNG ship Berge Everett, which is under long-term charter to SUEZ LNG NA, a subsidiary of SUEZ Energy North America, and was purchased by Shell NA LNG LLC, whose parent company Royal Dutch Shell owns a 50% equity stake in the Altamira terminal.

"This deal demonstrates the unique position and capabilities of SUEZ within the global LNG industry," said Dirk Beeuwsaert, CEO of SUEZ Energy International. "We are pleased to serve the newest LNG import facility in North America and look forward to strengthening our position in the North American LNG market substantially within the next few years."
